

Permission to Drive/Ride

The school is responsible for all students and must know where they are at all times. Students who leave the campus need to have parent permission. Students need to sign out in the office prior to leaving and upon returning to school, unless leaving on a class-sponsored trip.

If you choose NOT to allow your child to leave the school grounds, please contact the office to let us know of your alternative arrangements.

**In the event your high school child should become ill during the day, we will make sure you are notified before they leave.**

With your permission, your child can leave the campus for school sponsored activities (i.e., clubs, activities, classes, field trips, athletic practices, etc.)

- . (For all students grade 6 - 12) I Grant permission for my child to leave the campus for the school sponsored activities (i.e., clubs, activities, classes, field trips, athletic practices, etc.)
  
- High School students enrolled in Career and Tech Ed may need to drive to their place of employment. By granting permission here, your child will be able to drive during the school day to their career placement.
  
- Students attending college classes at HHS: these classes are taught on a college calendar, and there may be times when class is not in session. If classes ARE in session, students are expected to be here. With your permission, your child may leave the building when classes are NOT in session.
  
- Students in high school sports that practice off campus and require driving: Do you give permission for your child to drive and/ride with a legal driver 16 years of age or older to a school sponsored activity.
